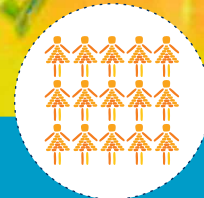


PARTNERSHIPS FOR CHANGE TO PREVENT VAW

15 organizations identified and supported by partner organizations to conduct sessions – in the Horn, East and Southern Africa (Somalia, Namibia, Zimbabwe, Kenya and Botswana)



About **218** individuals were engaged in different sessions conducted using In Her Shoes kit to help facilitate discussions on the prevention of VAW in order to;

- **Deepen empathy**
- **Promote self-reflection**
- **Strengthen support services**
- **Inspire Activism**
